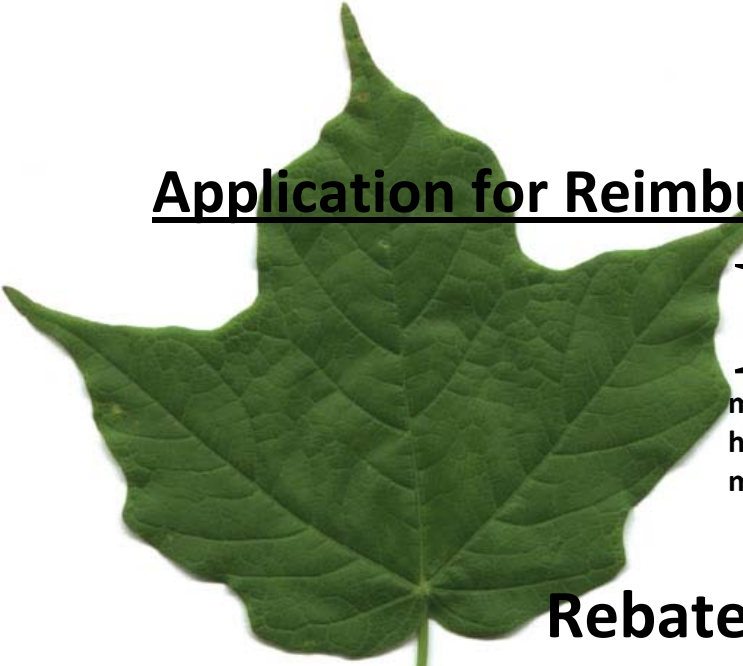


# Application for Reimbursement



**B**artlett Electric Cooperative's B-Green is an incentive program (*effective March 25, 2010*) offering rebates to residential members who make qualified energy efficiency improvements to their homes. The program is a great way for residential members to use energy more efficiently and save money.

### Heat Pump Rebate

Members who replace existing HVAC equipment (in electric-only, single family homes) are eligible to receive a **\$100** rebate for a 14 SEER (with an HSPF of 8.2) High Efficiency Heat Pump and a **\$200** rebate for a 15 SEER (with an HSPF of 9.0) High Efficiency Heat Pump (or higher).

The incentive rebates for this program apply for replacement of existing HVAC equipment at any residential home and new home construction. The member must provide a copy of the receipt and the Air-Conditioning Heating and Refrigeration Institute ("AHRI") certificate from the installing contractor for verification purposes. This incentive rebate is not applicable for homes that use natural gas for heating.

### HVAC Tune-Up

Residential members who have an energy audit performed on their single family homes are eligible to receive up to a \$100 rebate on an HVAC tune-up performed by a qualified service professional. An annual HVAC tune up includes: checking and correcting the unit's refrigerant pressure and tubing, checking and adjusting belt tension, cleaning and lubricating the indoor blower unit, replacing filters, cleaning inside the "A" coil, and checking the thermostat, wiring, and other electric parts. A copy of the receipt from a qualified contractor stating that the work above was completed must be provided for verification purposes.

**EnergyStar® Home Rebate**

Members who build EnergyStar rated homes (that closed after June 1, 2009) are eligible to receive a \$500 rebate. A copy of the EnergyStar certificate is required to be eligible for this program.

**Ceiling Insulation**

The recommended R-values for existing homes in the BEC Service Area is R38 for the ceiling and R13 for the walls. Members who upgrade to at least **R38** insulation in their home can receive a **\$275.00 rebate**.
